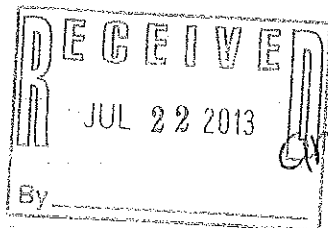


Edison Animal Shelter,
