2017 SUMMER PLAYGROUND PROGRAM

Playgrounds will be open for Edison Township residents, age 5 to age 12, from July 3rd to August 11th, Monday through Friday, 9:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. (weather permitting). A variety of activities will be held on the playgrounds for the children; including Arts & Crafts, Games, Science, Trips and Special Events at the following locations: Capestro, Edison Woods, Elder, Ellmyer, Lindquist, Menlo Park, Stelton, Washington, and Yelencsics.

Due to the popularity of the Stelton and Elder Playgrounds, program activities at these sites will be run according to age groups. The age groups are: ages 5/6, 7/8, 9/10, 11/12; or possibly ages: 5-8 and 9-12. This depends on the number of children registering at these playgrounds. Very rarely will age groups mix together for activities. Therefore, if you would like to keep siblings of different age groups together, please sign up at any of the other six playgrounds

The Stelton Playground will be the only playground that can accommodate children with disabilities. Please contact the Edison Recreation Office with any A.D.A. concerns or questions.

There is a \$40.00 non-refundable registration fee for each registered child. Checks or money orders only will be accepted on the playground starting July 3rd.
