### Directions to the Sites

**Dunellen Public Works, 235 Hall St., Dunellen, 08812**

**From I-287:**

Take Rt. 1 to I-287 north (Somerville). Take the exit for Rt. 529/Dunellen. Merge onto Stelton Rd. (Rt. 529). Go straight through 3 lights. After passing a gas station on the left, turn left to stay on Stelton Rd. (Do not follow Rt. 529). Go through one light. At the second light (end of road) turn left onto Lakeview Avenue. Almost immediately the road turns to the right, turning into New Market Rd. Just after passing a school on the left (at a triangle) turn left onto Grove St. Go through one light and follow until the road turns into South Ave. (Harry's Deli on right). Go two blocks and turn left onto Hall St. Dunellen Public Works is at the end of Hall Street on the left.

**East Brunswick Reclamation Center (Recycling Center), 357 Dunhams Corner Rd., East Brunswick, 08816**

**From Rt. 18:**

Take Rt. 18 south to Cranbury Rd. (Rt. 535 south). Bear right at the fork onto Dunhams Corner Rd. and continue for approximately 2.5 miles. The Reclamation Center will be on the right before reaching Church Ln.

**From Rt. 130:**

Take Rt. 130 north. After passing the sign for the Middlesex County Adult Corrections facility on the right, bear right onto Old Georges Rd. at the sign for Maple Meade. Pass the Church Lane Plaza on the left and turn right onto Church Ln. Follow Church Ln. until it ends and turn left onto Dunhams Corner Rd. The Reclamation Center will be on the left.

**OR**

Take Cranbury/South River Rd. (Rt. 535 North) and turn left onto Dunhams Corner Rd. After passing the Crystal Springs Aquatic Center on the right, look for the Reclamation Center on the left, just past Church Ln.

**Helmetta, 51 Main St. (behind Borough Hall), Helmetta, 08828**

**From Rt. 18:**

Take Rt. 18 to Rt. 615 south. Rt. 615 is also known as Bordentown Ave / Main St. Follow Main St. into Spotswood. Stay on Main St. for about 1.5 miles until the road splits. Bear left staying on 615 south (green street sign at fork says Manalapan Rd). Continue for just under 2 miles and turn left at the Helmetta Municipal Building. Paint drop-off is behind Borough Hall.

**From Rt. 130:**

Take Rt. 130 to Church Ln. (via Georges Rd.). Follow Church Ln. east until it intersects with Dunhams Corner Rd. and turn right. Follow Dunhams Corner Rd. until it turns into Helmetta Blvd. (at traffic light). Continue until Helmetta Blvd. merges with Lake Ave. bearing left at the fork. Make the first right at stop sign (continuing on Lake Ave.) and proceed to Main St. At Main St. turn right and travel about 100 feet to the Helmetta Municipal Building on the left. Paint drop-off is behind Borough Hall.
