# How to Register Online

- Please reserve your spot to get a vaccine now by pre-registering with the NJ Vaccine Scheduling System (NJVSS) online at <https://covidvaccine.nj.gov>
- The online form will ask some questions to determine when you are eligible to receive a vaccination.
- Filling out this form should take about 15 minutes, and the information you enter will be kept private with the State of New Jersey.

# How to Register via Phone

- Please call [855-568-0545](tel:855-568-0545) for help with the NJ Vaccine Scheduling System. The hotline is open from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. every day and can help callers in more than 240 different languages. Due to high call volumes, callers are experiencing long wait times. 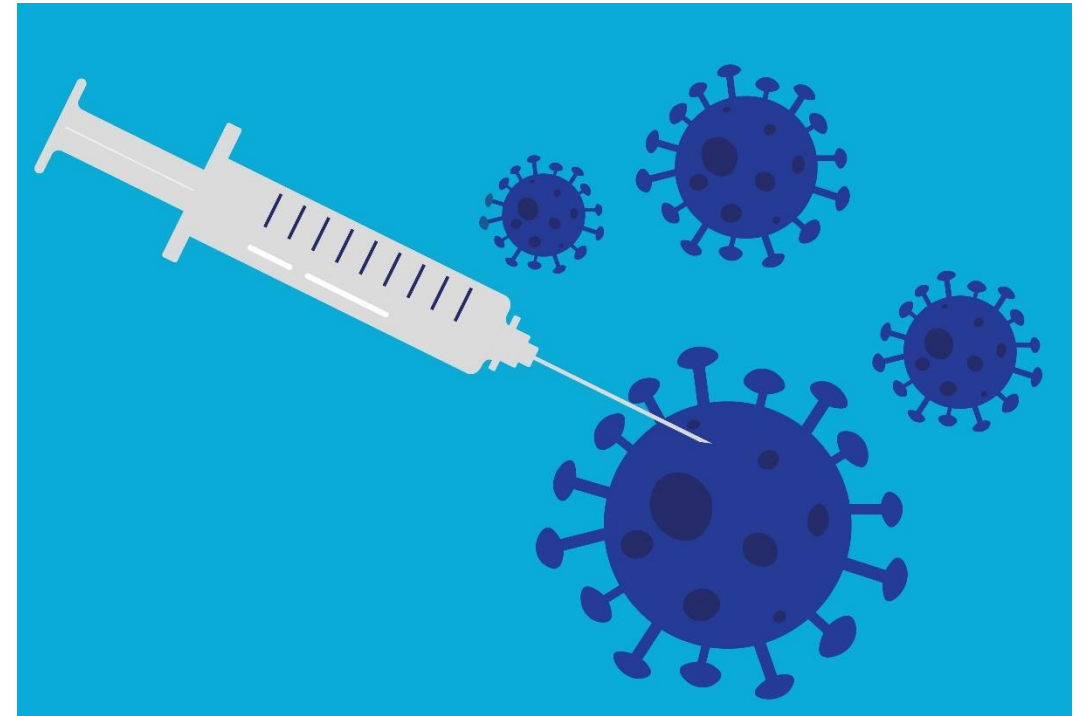

# Who is currently eligible?

Currently, vaccines are available to the following groups:

- Aged 65 and older
- Aged 16-64 that have certain medical conditions that increase the risk of severe illness from the virus
- Childcare workers in licensed and registered settings
- Educators and staff, pre-K to 12
- First responders including sworn law enforcement and fire professionals
- Healthcare workers, paid and unpaid
- High-risk individuals
- Long-term care and high-risk congregate care facility residents and staff
- Public safety workers

- Transportation workers
- Food production, agriculture, and food distribution workers
- Eldercare and support personnel
- Warehousing and logistics workers
- Social service workers and support staff
- Elections personnel
- Hospitality workers
- Medical supply chain employees
- Postal and shipping service workers
- Clergy
- Workers in the Judicial system



# Upcoming Eligibility Changes:

- Beginning **April 5th**, individuals aged 55 and older, additional frontline essential workers, and individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities 16 and over, will be eligible to book appointments.



If you are eligible but have not yet been notified about available appointments in the NJ Vaccine Scheduling System, there are additional ways to get vaccinated:

- Make an appointment directly with a vaccination location that does not use the NJ Vaccine Scheduling System.
- If you work or volunteer at a select healthcare facility, make an appointment through your place of work.
- Veterans who receive care from VA health facilities or live in VA long-term care facilities may be eligible for vaccines through the VA.

# Expanding Vaccine Capacity and Access

- If you don't qualify for a vaccine at this time, after registration through the [NJ Vaccine Scheduling System](#), you will be notified when the vaccine is available.
- Even if you are eligible for receiving a vaccine, an appointment may not be immediately available to you in the first weeks of the vaccination campaign due to significantly limited vaccine availability. New Jersey is developing an extensive network of vaccination sites to serve those currently eligible for vaccination.
