

Sewer Billing

Edison Sewer charges are billed once annually and are based on prior year water consumption. If any prior year water billings are based on estimated meter readings, then these readings were also used for calculating this sewer bill. Any adjustments to the estimated readings will be reflected the following year.

The property owner is responsible for paying the sewer bill. Tenants should forward this bill to the landlord unless your rental agreement requires tenant payment. This bill should be given to the new owner or his paying agent upon sale or exchange of the property. Please advise this office of any changes in property ownership or mailing address. Mortgage companies are not responsible for paying sewer charges. It is not included in your monthly mortgage payment and must be paid separately.

Payments: Sewer charges are payable bi-annually. The payment for the first half is due on the date indicated on the front of this bill, payment Stub # 1, usually between April and June. The payment for the second half, payment Stub # 2, is due October 1 of each year. Please include appropriate stub with remittance. If you choose to pay the bill for the entire year, please include both payment stubs with remittance.

Interest: Any municipal charges remaining unpaid by the due dates are subject to interest at the rate of up to 8% per annum up to \$1,500.00, and 18% per annum over \$1,500.00. A penalty of up to 6% may be charged on any total municipal delinquency in excess of \$10,000.00 if not paid by the end of the year. A grace period not exceeding 10 days is provided from the due date.

Receipts: Remittances requiring a receipt must be accompanied by the entire bill along *with a self-addressed stamped envelope*. Otherwise, detach the appropriate payment stub and mail with your check. Your cancelled check will be your receipt.

Tax Sale: Any municipal charge remaining unpaid on the eleventh day of November of the current year is subject to Tax Sale. (Ch. 99, PL 1997)

Sewer Deductions: Residential customers receive a 15% outside water use discount which has already been deducted from the total amount due on the bill. Senior property owners who are 65 year of age, and provide proof of age, are entitled to a Rate Freeze in their primary residence. Proof of age could be provided by just applying for a senior card at the Edison Township Senior Center (732-248-7345) or by bringing, emailing, faxing or mailing an acceptable proof of age to the Tax Office no later than March 1 of the calendar year. Acceptable proof(s) of age shall include but not be limited to a Township identification card, valid drivers license, birth certificate, passport or County identification card, as determined by the Director of Finance.
